eXcite^{OSA} Description

eXciteOSA is a tongue neuromuscular electrical stimulation (NMES) device for Obstructive Sleep Apnea (OSA) with adjustable stimulation manufactured by Signifier Medical Technologies, LLC.

The device includes 3 parts in order to operate:

1. **Mouthpiece** – a universal sized silicone disposable mouthpiece with 4 electrodes, which must be replaced every 90 days. Single patient use only.
2. **USB-C charging cable** – connects to the control unit via USB connection
3. **Control Unit (with Bluetooth)** - a durable control unit with life expectancy of a least 36 months, which can be cleaned and refurbished
